- I need help in the classroom the sign-up sheets are outside of our door.
- Book reports are due on 9/30.
- The students will be singing in church on 9/26 for Christian Education Sunday. They will sing in the 10:45 traditional service.
- Our first field trip will be to Cozy Cow Dairy and Miller Farms on 9/11. Both of these places are in the Longmont area so we will need to leave the school by 8:30 am. We will not return until 3:15. As of this typing I have two parents to help. **Please make sure to send in a car seat for your child, the new state law states that all children under the age of 8 must be in a booster seat.** We will drive to the dairy farm first and take that tour and taste some dairy items. We also will be petting some farm animals. If your child is allergic to fur, please let me know. We will then drive to the vegetable farm and eat lunch. Then, the students will have a time to play on dirt piles, drive trikes, go in a maze, ect. Then, we will sit on hay bales on a tractor trailer out to the fields. We will be able to get off and go in the field and pick vegetables to take home. Parents please dress for the

weather, it gets hot on the farm, but for some children the hay really bothers their skin so plan accordingly. Also, please apply sunscreen and pack water for them to drink. Again, if there is any allergy concerns please let me know. Pray for good weather, if it is muddy we cannot go!

- Remember we will not have school on 9/6 due to Labor Day.
- The fall fund raising packet is due back on 9/7.
- We will be starting math fact sheets in the classroom next week. Each day the students will be timed at school for one side of the sheet and then you will need to time them for the second side at home. They will need to return the sheet completed each morning. We will be timing them for one minute 45 seconds, if the amount of time changes I will have your student write it at the top of the sheet. After four practice sheets they will have a test on those facts. The practice sheets are not recorded for grades only the test sheets. It is very important that second grade memorize their addition and subtraction facts. A great place to practice these facts is in the car while driving to your next location. Thank you for your help with this.

If you see that your child is being cared for by another staff member or a sub at pick-up time that is where I am.
